Codebook for downloads of SDQ publications

Types of studies not included in the publications database:

• Studies that use the SDQ illegally, e.g. with illegal modifications to the questions or in an unauthorised translation.

- Systematic reviews that list the SDQ as one measure used in primary studies.
- Studies that mention the SDQ in passing (e.g. as an example measure) or state that it was collected but do not present any related results.

url	URL of the publication.	'-2' = unknown
countries	List of countries in which SDQs were administered in the study. For publications where we could not access the full text, we sought to assign this based on the location of the home institutions of the publication's authors.	'-2' = unknown '-8' = not applicable (e.g. as the publication is a review). Questionmarks indicate uncertainty.
languages	List of languages in which SDQs were administered in the study. Unless this was explicitly stated, we sought to assign this based on where the study took place.	'-2' = unknown '-8' = not applicable (e.g. as the publication is a review). Questionmarks indicate uncertainty.
year	Year in which the publication was published.
